### Sarcophagus Monuments

**S**ARCOPHAGUS, a word derived from the Greek signifying "flesh eating," originally applied in this connection to coffins made of limestone, which have the property of consuming bodies placed within.

The simplest form of the Sarcophagus Type of monument is a rectangular block of stone rough hewn or polished, on one, two or three bases. The height ought never to be greater than the longer dimensions of the base, and should seldom exceed the shorter.

### Obelisk Monument

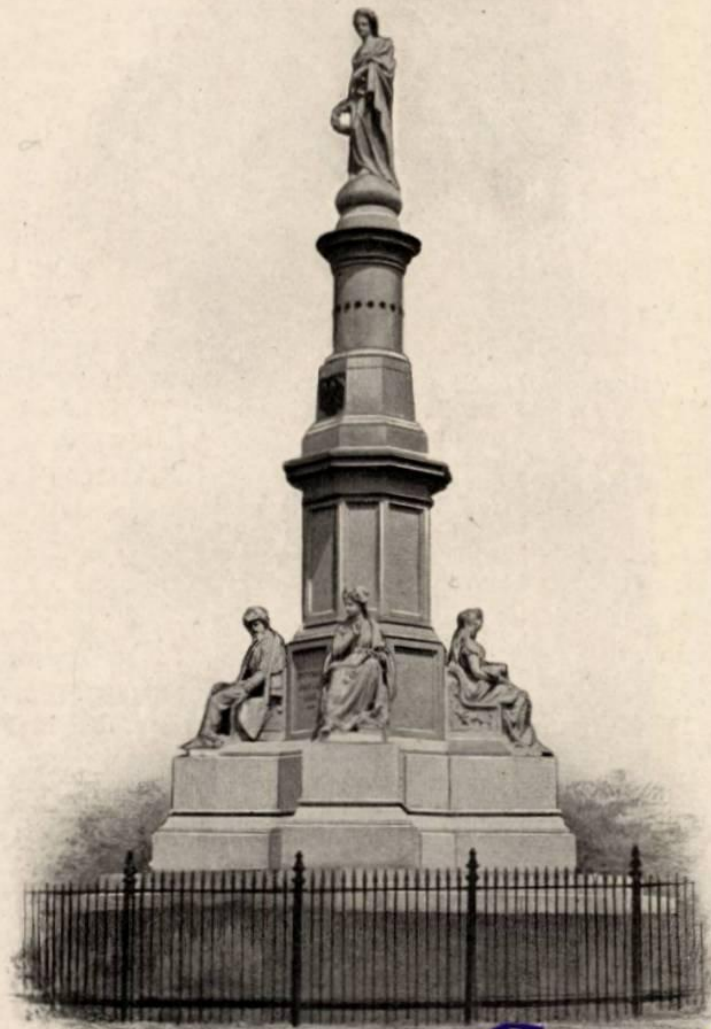
